August Trip

Number of Participants: 71 (in 8 crews of 9:2--underenrolled)

Number of Staff: 35 (largest staff to date)

The large number of staff (a basecamp of 19) caused concerns. Basecamp was divided into 4-5 person "mini-crews." One mini-crew was allowed to hike and camp away from Cedar Rock and another was to clean up basecamp while two crews facilitated climbing. Staffers liked the smaller groups but none ever camped away from basecamp.

The traditional course-end potluck dinner at Cove was scrapped by staff, citing selfishness and competition as the chief problems. Big group games were played instead.

One van drove off a mountain road when the gravel shoulder gave way. No one was injured.
